Bridge Project Update

The transformation of the Missouri River crossing continues with steady progress on the Fort Pierre plaza area and surrounding infrastructure, while work on the Pierre side plaza has officially concluded. Crews are now focused on final touches including lighting, landscaping, and sidewalk completion as the project moves closer to the finish line.

A recent highlight in the Fort Pierre plaza was the re-installation of the memorial stone honoring Lt. Cmdr. John C. Waldron. Crews are actively working on sidewalk installation, riprap touch-ups, and conduit placement for plaza lighting. Preparations are also underway to complete the plaza stairs in the coming weeks, along with planning for slope seeding in the Fort Pierre plaza. Once all concrete work is finalized, installation of walkway lighting will begin.

Meanwhile, touch-up painting of the bridge railing has been completed and approved, and crews have begun demobilizing and disassembling the final crane, with removal expected this week.
